***Helen Stacey *Roslyn Lock and Bruce Stewart *Barry Hill**

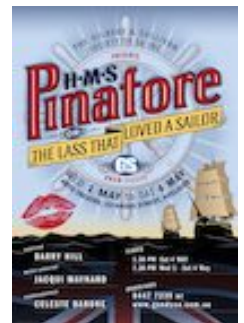
