

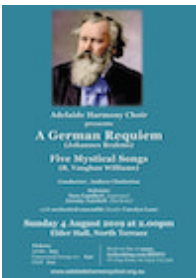


GUESTS ON KALEIDOSCOPE: 17 and 20 July 2019
