



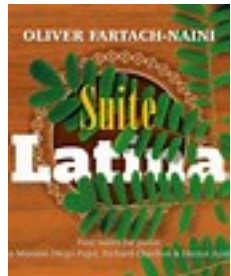
Guests on Kaleidoscope 13 and 16 May 2020
