Matthew Flinders circumnavigated Australia in a small boat, the *Investigator*, with an aboriginal assistant, his cat and his flute. Nicholas Baudin, in a slightly larger boat, *Le Geographe*, explored the Australian coastline. His ship also contained sailors who loved music. In 1802 the two met in Encounter Bay. There is music pertaining to this event, by noted composers, such as Haydn, Mozart, Pleyel and Sculthorpe.
