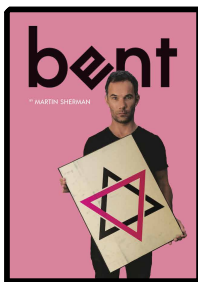




Kaleidoscope 7 and 10 October 2020
